

Terry Kimbrough Blanket to match the 2 roses gown

Materials - 4 ply yarn. Size 9 needles

Cast on 132 stitches loosely

Follow pattern for gown until work measures approx 15 ins.

NB only count stitches after pattern rows 1 and 6

LITTLE ANGELS

BOOTEE IN 4 PLY

With size 10 (3.25mm) needles cast on 25 sts

Knit 1 row increasing in 12th and 13th sts (27 sts)

Purl 1 row

Knit 1 row increasing in 12th and 13th sts (29 sts)

Work a further 5 rows in stocking stitch

Decrease 1 st at each of of next two rows (25 sts)

Work a further 2 rows in stocking stitch

Change to size 12 (2.5mm) needles and work 14 rows in K1, P1 rib

Change to size 10 (3.25mm) needles and cast off.

Sew up loosely with flat seam.



MINI HAT

Use 4 ply yarn and size 10 (3¼mm) needles

Cast on 44 stitches fairly loosely.

Work 2 inches in K1, P1 rib.

Work 10 rows in stocking stitch (one row Knit, one row Purl)

Next row	:	(K5, K2 tog) repeat to last 2 sts, K2	38 sts
Next row	:	Purl	
Next row	:	(K4, K2 tog) repeat to last 2 sts, K2	32 sts
Next row	:	Purl	
Next row	:	(K3, K2 tog) repeat to last 2 sts, K2	26 sts
Next row	:	Purl	
Next row	:	(K2, K2 tog) repeat to last 2 sts, K2	20 sts
Next row	:	Purl	
Next row	:	(K1, K2 tog) repeat to last 2 sts, K2	14 sts
Next row	:	Purl	
Next row	:	K2 tog across row, break yarn and thread through last 7 sts, sew up seam flat and fold over rib.
